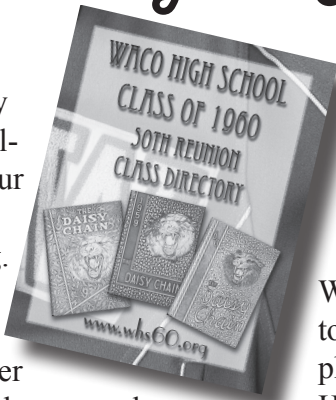

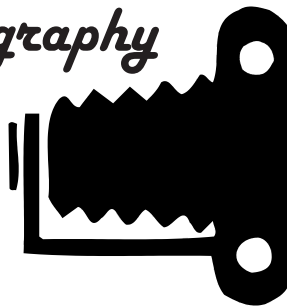
## Class Directory

## Photography

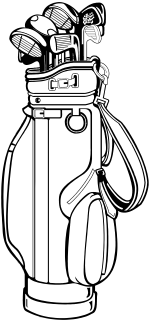

## Golf Tournament

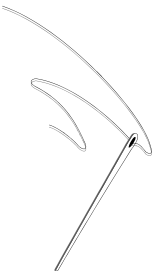
