Herman Ray Londenberg, of Thornton, passed away at his residence Wednesday, December 16, 2009. Funeral services will be 11 a.m. Monday, December 21, at Peace Lutheran Church, 9301 Panther Way in Hewitt, Texas, with Pastor Stephen Rynearson officiating. Burial will follow at Waco Memorial Park.
